Recommendations and Guidelines for Participation in the Alabama PALS Clean Campus Program:

- 1. Apply or reenroll for membership in the program either on the attached form or online at www.alpals.org. The program is FREE to all Alabama schools. **Please obtain Principal permission to participate.**
- 2. Assign a faculty member, existing club, or grade level to "manage/oversee" the program. The school then decides how to customize the program to meet the unique needs of your students. Some schools keep it very simple and others "go the extra mile" with their programs. We are happy to have your school involved either way, and our Clean Campus Coordinator is here to help kickstart your program!
- 3. Schedule a visit with the Clean Campus Coordinator to come to your school for a 30-minute presentation to your students. This presentation meets "teacher standards" for Environmental Education.
- 4. Plan at least one campus-wide cleanup. Some schools perform monthly or weekly cleanups, but this is not required. We would like for students to at least participate in one cleanup to see what kind of litter accumulates on campus and make them more aware of litter in general. PALS will provide bags for any on-campus cleanups.
- 5. Encourage participation in the K-6th Poster Contest and 7th-12th Recycled Art Contest in the spring and the Clean Campus Scrapbook Contest in the fall.
- 6. Reference our online litter curriculum for classroom activity ideas to incorporate more environmental education.

- 7. Encourage students to participate in your local "Don't Drop it on Alabama" Spring Cleanup in April to help cleanup and prevent litter in your community.
- 8. Get creative with campus beautification projects such as planting flowers, creating recycled art or hanging birdhouses on campus. We can help with outdoor classroom ideas, as well!
- **9. Participate in ongoing recycling** if it is available in your area.

CLEAN CAMPUS PROGRAM

Target Group:

All Alabama students K-12. All city, county and private schools.

Purpose of Clean Campus Program:

To implement litter education and involvement in community and campus cleanup efforts. To be used as a "springboard" for implementing litter education into Alabama school systems.

Applying for Program:

Schools must apply each year, even if your school has been a member in previous years. You may apply online at **www.alpals.org** (click the Clean Campus tab for info) or by returning the attached application form by mail.

> **Dates for Program:** August-May

Recognition for Participating Schools: Each participating school will qualify to nominate themselves for the State Clean Campus Award to be presented at the Governor's Awards program in November. The FIRST place school will receive a \$1,000 scholarship, 2nd place a \$750 scholarship, and 3rd place

a \$500 scholarship. In addition to the scholarship money, the State Winner will be presented signs to be displayed at their campus proclaiming the respective school as Alabama's Clean Campus Winner.
