## Recommendations and Guidelines for Participation in the Alabama PALS Clean Campus Program:

- Determine who will manage the program at the school (I.e. faculty member, existing club, specific grade level, etc.) and have them create goals and a plan for the program. You may even want to create a Clean Campus Committee comprised of students, parents and faculty members that meets 2-3 times a semester to evaluate the progress of the program.
- Hold regular campus wide cleanups.
- Participate in ongoing recycling if available in your county.
- Schedule the Clean Campus Coordinator to visit your school or zoom with your students for a 30-minute presentation. She can also help with organizing and kickstarting the program if needed.

- Introduce Environmental Education Program at school. Reference our online litter curriculum for classroom activity ideas.
- Encourage participation in the K-6th Poster Contest and the 7th-12th Recycled Art Contest in the spring and the Clean Campus Scrapbook Competition in the fall.
- If possible, participate in your local "Don't Drop it on Alabama" Spring Cleanup in April to help cleanup and prevent litter in your community.
- Get creative with campus beautification projects such as planting flowers, creating recycled art or hanging birdhouses on campus. We can help with outdoor classroom ideas, as well!
- Obtain permission from school Principal to participate in program.

The Clean Campus Program is intended to be customized for what works best for your school. You may decide to keep it simple or "go the extra mile" with your program. We are happy to have your school involved either way! Let us know if we can help you as you get started!

# CLEAN CAMPUS PROGRAM

### Target Group:

All Alabama students K-12. All city, county and private schools.

### **Purpose of Clean Campus Program:**

To implement litter education and involvement in community and campus cleanup efforts. To be used as a "springboard" for implementing litter education into Alabama school systems.

### **Applying for Program:**

Schools must apply each year, even if your school has been a member in previous years. You may apply online at **www.alpals.org** (click the Clean Campus tab for info) or by returning the attached application form by mail.

> Dates for Program: August-May

Recognition for Participating Schools: Each participating school will qualify to nominate themselves for the State Clean Campus Award to be presented at the Governor's Awards program in November. The FIRST place school will receive a \$1,000 scholarship, 2<sup>nd</sup> place a \$750 scholarship, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place a \$500 scholarship. In addition to the scholarship money, the State Winner will be presented signs to be displayed at their campus proclaiming the respective school as Alabama's Clean Campus Winner.
