Five Easy Steps

Step 1: Locate a mile of County, State or U.S. Highway that you or your group is interested in “adopting.”

Step 2: Fill out the Adopt-A-Mile application form and mail to:

Step 3: Processing of your application will be handled by Alabama PALS. Your Adopt-A-Mile sign will be ordered using the information you provide.

Step 4: Your signs will be erected approximately six weeks from the date your application is processed.

Step 5: To ensure that this program continues to be effective, it is suggested that you or your group clean your respective mile every four to six weeks. Alabama PALS will have all adopted miles inspected periodically to ensure compliance within the program.
